M: Every human society has rules covering marriage. In Britain it is illegal to marry under the age of 18 without parents' permission. You may marry your first cousin but you cannot marry anyone who is a closer relative than this.

In some societies the rules are stricter. There are places where the men must marry outside their family. For the Nuer tribe in the Sudan this means that a man usually has to find a wife in a different village because the people in his village belong to the same family. The Nuer say, "We marry those with whom we fight."In this way friendship is increased between enemy villages.

Other societies have a rule which says that a man must marry a daughter of his mother's brother. Another common marriage custom says that a man is supposed to marry a cousin on his mother's side but he needn't if he does not want to. People who live in Northern Burma are an example of this practice.

Rules play an important part in any society. Sometimes these rules may seem rather strange unnecessary to us. However, as we can see Nuer enemies have to become friends because of the marry out rule. Marriage rules affect where people live and who owns the property and are therefore very important in the organization of the whole society.
